Since then, the program has developed into one of the best in South-East Queensland, with high-quality coaching, pastoral care and behavioural expectations driving it's success.

Boys in the RLX program will have the opportunity to play in competitions not available to most schools in the Greater-Brisbane area. Our teams compete in the top competitions offered to South-East Queensland schoolboys, facilitated by the Brisbane Broncos.

A student will remain eligible as a course participant if they continue to meet the excellent standards upon which their acceptance was initially determined.

Students enrolled in Programs of Excellence must maintain a high level of effort, behaviour and attendance in all classes in order to keep their position in the program. At any time after the program has commenced, Redcliffe State High School reserves the right to remove a student from a Program of Excellence for reasons of behaviour, attendance or academic suitability.

CURRICULUM AND

LEARNING

Rugby League Excellence students in years 7 to 10 are assessed against the Heath and Physical Education achievement standard of the Australian Curriculum. Over 8 semesters, students develop the skills, knowledge, and understanding to strengthen their sense of self, and build and manage satisfying, respectful relationships. They learn to build on personal and community strengths and assets to enhance safety and wellbeing. They critique and challenge assumptions and stereotypes and learn to navigate a range of health-related sources, services and organisations.

Students in years 11 and 12 complete the senior sport and recreation syllabus. As part of this program, students investigate local community resources that aid in the facilitation of sport, fitness and leisure activities. They develop the necessary skills to run sporting tournaments with the hope that these skills can be used to benefit their communities. Students also learn to coach both individuals and small groups in a range of sport and fitness settings.

Many of our students receive additional learning support during the school Academic Intervention Response (AIR) time, held each Friday between 1:30pm-2:40pm. This allows students to catch up on key learning they may have missed due to their sporting commitments. Many students are also identified by their class teachers as needing additional support in the area of literacy. As a response to this, a designated Rugby League Excellence literacy support class also runs during AIR time and is coordinated by one of the RLX coaches.





PROGRAM FEES

Students in Rugby League Excellence will need access to a range of school resources to fully participate in the course. Therefore, continued enrolment in the program is contingent upon Student Resource Scheme fees being paid or having an agreed payment plan in place.

We would like to acknowledge our wonderful sponsors who ensure that we can keep our fees to a minimum. In 2024 we have once again kept our fees at the same price as previous seasons - \$350 for all year levels.

The fees will cover:

- · training shirt, shorts and hat
- · Playing Shorts and Socks
- · All travel costs including to and from games and camps
- · RLX Camp Venue is determined by year level
- · any playing costs associated with the Rugby League program eg strapping
- Access to video analysis programs for our senior cohorts.
- Guest coaching and speakers throughout the year
- End of season presentation nights
