### Selection Process

1.<u>APPLY</u>

- Register for a trial or audition and complete both: The Selective Entry Program Application Form and either the Expression of Interest (EOI) for Out of Catchment students or Enrolment paperwork for In Catchment students

#### 2.<u>TRIAL</u>

- Students participate in program specific trials or auditions during Week 10, Term 2:

#### 3.<u>SHORTLIST</u>

- Students will be shortlisted based on their performance, with successful applicants notified. Out of Catchment students will receive formal enrolment offers at this stage.

#### 4.<u>ENROL</u>

- Families finalise enrolment by attending an enrolment interview and paying the relevant program fees.

Once families register for a trial or audition, our school will contact them with further information and permissions specific to their chosen program.
