

## Selection Process

### 1. APPLY

– Register for a trial or audition and complete both: The Selective Entry Program Application Form and either the Expression of Interest (EOI) for Out of Catchment students or Enrolment paperwork for In Catchment students

### 2. TRIAL

– Students participate in program specific trials or auditions during Week 10, Term 2:

### 3. SHORTLIST

– Students will be shortlisted based on their performance, with successful applicants notified. Out of Catchment students will receive formal enrolment offers at this stage.

### 4. ENROL

– Families finalise enrolment by attending an enrolment interview and paying the relevant program fees. Once families register for a trial or audition, our school will contact them with further information and permissions specific to their chosen program.

## Selection Criteria

Drama is not merely about acting. Essentially, we are looking for a range of qualities including

- Enthusiasm

- Willingness to learn
- Theatre analysis
- A passion for Drama and the Performing Arts
- Aptitude and willingness to work in all areas of their curriculum
- Basic literacy (C in ENG and completion of a written component at DRX audition)



- Primary School report and teacher's comments regarding behaviour and effort (We would expect to see only positive comments in these areas – ideally 'B's and above)
- Ability to work effectively as part of a group
- Leadership qualities
- Motivation for wanting to be an active part of the program
- An effective and enthusiastic manner
- A willingness to accept unfamiliar tasks and challenges
- Aptitude and eagerness to learn and approach new material and concepts
