SABER GUIDELINES.

The SABER Scheme is a recognition system for students who go 'above and beyond' the school's expectations. This can be either for academic excellence and / or outstanding leadership, school and community services, sport and cultural endeavours.

The following is a list of *behaviours/achievements* by which a SABER slip should be issued. It also lists the relevant *person* to issue the award, and the *frequency* of issue of SABER slips.

| 7. Demonstration of work ethic, attitude, manners, respect and participation IN CLASS on a consistent and sustained level which is 'above and beyond.' | Teaching staff | 1 per term. |
| 8. Participation in SCHOOL SERVICE event (e.g. ushers, , mentoring, reddi showcase volunteer, etc.) | Relevant teaching personnel | As per involvement. |
| 9. Participation in COMMUNITY SERVICE event that is RSHS- sanctioned (e.g. Reddi Committs events, Clean Up Australia, Shave For A Cure, etc.) | Relevant teaching personnel | As per involvement. |
| 10. Participation in ACADEMIC event (e.g. Maths comp., Science comp., Redcliffe Show entry as part of RSHS submission) | Relevant teaching personnel | As per involvement. |
| 11. Demonstration of Respect Goal focus. | Teaching staff | 1 per Semester. |
| 12. Exceeding SABER Target set, provided the original Target is aspirational. | Teaching Staff | 1 per Semester. |

CAVEAT:

For the SABER Scheme to maintain its integrity and value, it is expected that the above behaviours/achievements will be recognised by the issuing of SABER slips, certificates etc.

Equally, it is also expected that the following behaviours form part of the normal and expected standards of all RSHS students, and thus are unable to be recognised as warranting the issuing of SABER slips. These are:

- Behaviour in accordance with RSHS standards and expectations.
- Completion of homework.
- Submission of required and mandated assessment items.
- Completion of routine class work and course work.

SABER Application Process:

If students have not received a SABER Slip/Certificate etc and they feel they should have received a SABER Slip for the achievements outlined in this document, they can complete the form below to apply for the SABER Slip. This form can be collected from the SABER centre.

The form needs to be given to the staff member in charge of the activity.
