Introduction

Attendance

Guarantee maximum attendance for your child at school. Students should only be absent from school if they are unfit to attend school. This is the same for the workplace – regular attendance is a lifelong skill that students can translate into their working career. If your child is unable to attend, the school must be notified on the day of the absence.
